Hector Manuel Rodriguez, 98, of St. Augustine, Florida, passed away peacefully on February 23, 2026, at Roberts Care Center in Palatka. Born and raised in Yabucoa, Puerto Rico, Hector was the beloved son of the late Jose and Victoria Rodriguez. From a young age, he developed a deep love for baseball. In high school, he played in the Double A division, and the sport remained his lifelong passion. 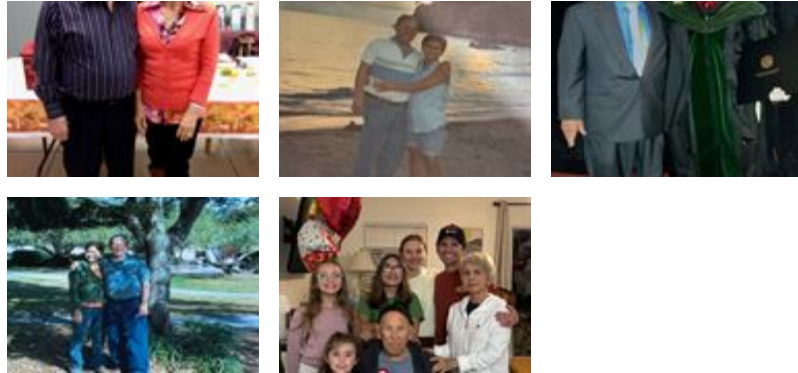
