Henry “Hank” Gordon, 76, of St. Augustine, Florida, passed away Saturday, August 31, 2019 at the Bailey Hospice in St. Augustine.

Hank was born on July 13, 1943 in Waycross, Georgia to E.W. “Jack” Gordon, Sr. and Maude (Herndon) Gordon. He graduated Grossmont High School in 1961, then a few years later served in the Army as a paratrooper. He was a veteran of the Vietnam War. Hank married Judy Dufford on September 24, 1967 in La Mesa, CA. He went back to school and graduated from San Diego State in 1970, and ended up spending 29 years at Chevron Corporation as an Accountant before retiring at age 55. It didn’t take long before he and Judy moved to Florida in 1999 to spend their retirement years.

During his adult years, when he wasn’t golfing on a Saturday, you could find him fixing up Volkswagen bugs, at his workbench in the garage fixing things or using his quiet imagination to make something out of nothing (like sandals made from tire tread and leftover leather straps - yep, he actually did that!), sitting in his lazy boy half-awake watching a golf tournament (eyes closed, mouth open...we change the channel; he says, “Hey, I was watching that”), or going out of his way to maximize a frugal life with all that he owned and did. He lived his retirement years enjoying numerous rounds of golf, traveling, gardening, working at the local theater creating backgrounds and props for plays, and dancing (as something new to try). He was glad he did. Dancing is how he and Amy met in 2010.

Hank was preceded in death by his parents, and his first wife, Judy Gordon.

Hank is survived by his wife, Amy McDermott; his daughter Karen (Gordon) McGuire & husband Mike; his son Adam Gordon & wife Amy; his brother E.W. "Jack" Gordon, Jr; and his 4 grandchildren: Derek Gordon, Brooke Gordon, Seth Gordon and Caleb McGuire. The last thing he said to us was "Ta-ta".
