Hubert Taylor "Johnny" Johnson, 75, of St. Augustine passed away on 12/02/2013 after a battle with leukemia. Mr. Johnson was born in West Palm Beach, FL and grew up in Niceville, FL. He graduated from Choctawhatchee High School in 1957. Upon completion of high school, he joined the United States Air Force as an aircraft mechanic. His first tour of duty was McGuire Air Force Base in New Jersey, where he met and married Arleen Fort. He rose to the rank of Senior Master Sergeant, and took special pride in his work with the C-130 aircraft. He also served our country at The Department of Defense as an aircraft maintenance trainer and a quality assurance inspector on the E8-A JSTARS program during Operation Desert Storm, and a tour of duty in Saudi Arabia, where he supervised the construction of a border radar system.

Always active in his community and church, he coached youth soccer and Little League Baseball, was active in community theater, participated in international mission trips, served on the administrative board and sang in the choir of his church. Funeral services will be held 11:30 a.m. Tuesday December 10, 2013 at St. Johns Family Funeral Home. Interment will follow at Jacksonville National Cemetery at 2:30 p.m. A visitation, beginning at 10:30 a.m., will precede the services.
