Irma Marie Dohrmann Scholten was born in Mt. Healthy, Ohio, on September 17, 1920. She was the elder daughter of Christian and Minnie Klein Dohrmann. She passed to her new heavenly life on February 24, 2015. Her younger sister, Crystal, and her parents predeceased her. On January 3, 1941, she was married to Bert Scholten, who also preceded her in death. Irma is survived by three children: Judy (Dale) Clyma, of Grayling, MI; Jim Scholten, of St. Augustine; and David (Deanie) Scholten of Taylorsville, KY; five grandchildren, and six great-grandchildren. Irma was a loving wife and mother, and led a life of volunteerism and service to others. As her family moved from one location to another in the Midwest, she established Brownie and Girl Scout troops where they had not existed before. She was also a Cub Scout leader, and a perpetual room mother for her children's classes. In Columbus, Ohio, she was active as a Sunday school teacher and youth group leader in her church, and served as a support person to a family sponsored by the church to come to this country. In Media, Pennsylvania, she volunteered with the Riddle Hospital Auxiliary, and was selected as both treasurer and chairman of the Auxiliary Thrift shop during her many years of service. In St. Augustine, she was a past member and officer of the Treasure Beach Property Owners' Association, and of the Crescent Beach Volunteer Fire Department. She worked at the polls for 25 years of her time here. At

Memorial Lutheran Church, over the years, she served on the church council, sang in the choir, was altar guild chairman, fellowship chairman, and social services chairman.
