Jack was well known and active in the propeller club, a Port of Jax. Business organization. Besides his Family and the Gators, Jack's favorite hobby and passion was golf. He was a regular at hidden hills country club either golfing with customers or his regular weekend foursome. Jack was also an officer in the Sons of Confederate Veterans, and enjoyed attending their annual Ball in full uniform. He was also a Free Mason and a member of the Shriners. Jack was a dedicated fan of his grandchildren's sporting and extracurricular activities. Jack and Marion attended baseball games, chorus concerts, track meets and football games there his granddaughters cheered, regardless of the weather or inconvenience he occurred. He spent much of the last 25 years caring for his

aging parents (both lived to 100) and then his wife Marion. Jack is survived by his wife of 59 years, Marion; sons, Robin (Paula), John (Annette); daughter Jodie Reddick (Bill).
