



Jack Edwards Rinehart

Jack Edwards Rinehart, Jr., age 63, of St. Augustine, passed away on January 23, 2019 at St. Vincent's Medical Center Southside in Jacksonville with his family by his side. Jack was born and raised in St. Augustine. He was a 1973 graduate of St. Augustine High School where he played for the Yellow Jacket Football team. Jack went on to attend Newberry College where he played football on a partial scholarship and was a member of the Delta Phi Fraternity. He later transferred to Troy University where he earned a Bachelor Degree in Social and Rehabilitative Services. After graduating, Jack returned to St. Augustine and went to work with the State of Florida Children's Services. He soon met his wife-to-be, Dee Isaac, who was a friend of his sister Stephanie. The couple married on December 29, 1978. For most of his career, Jack worked as a Family Resource Manager for the Jacksonville Children's Commission. He retired on March 23, 2012 after over 23 years of service. He was able to reconnect with his service with the State of Florida where he was currently working in the Guardian Ad Litem Program. Jack was a kind and gentle soul. He was well suited for the work he chose and did it with all his heart. More than anything Jack loved his family and enjoyed spending time with them. He will be deeply missed.

He is survived by his wife, Delores "Dee" Rinehart; a son, Jason Rinehart (Amy) of Jacksonville; his mother, Doris Rinehart of St. Augustine; sisters, Stephanie Morrow (Lester) of St. Augustine; Tracy Gowens (Darren) of St.

Augustine; and a brother, Brian Rinehart (Stacey) of New Jersey. He was preceded in death by his father, Jack Edwards "Rusty" Rinehart.

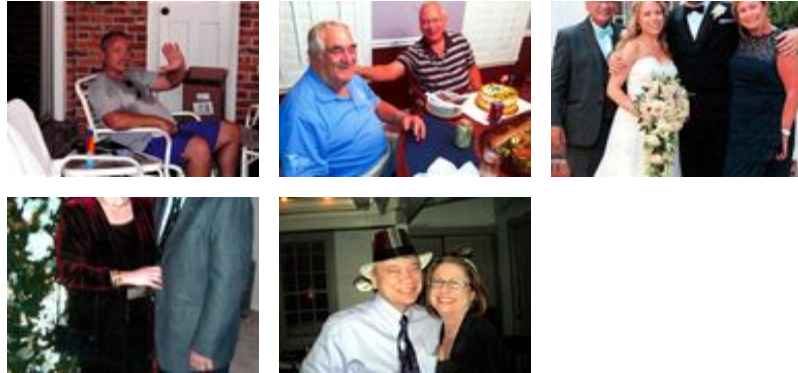
