He served in the 393rd Engineers Special Services and the 361st Engineers Special Regiment. He was sent to France, Germany, and Japan. He had many stories of his years in the service and also wrote a detailed 40 page account of his days in the service and it was truly an amazing story.

Funeral services will be held 1:30 p.m. Saturday November 30, 2019 at St. Johns Family Funeral Home. A visitation beginning at 12:00 p.m. Noon will precede the services.

Interment will follow in San Lorenzo Cemetery.

He is survived by his wife of 73 years, Clarice E. Moran; and many, many nieces, nephews, and cousins, too many to list.

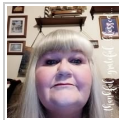
