



James Phillip "Jim" Spalding

James Phillip "Jim" Spalding, age 66, passed away on August 4, 2023 at his residence in St. Augustine, FL. James was born on May 24, 1957 in Covington, KY to parents James and Anna (Jones) Spalding. He grew up in Owenton, Kentucky and graduated from Owen County High School with the class of 1975. Shortly after graduating high school he moved to Orlando, Florida to attend U.C.F. He graduated from U.C.F. with a bachelor's degree. Jim worked as a mail carrier with the US Postal Service and was promoted to Postmaster of the Mineola Post Office. He also was elected and served as Mayor of Mineola. In the late 1990's Jim moved to St. Augustine and had most recently worked at the Father Time Clock Shop on St. George Street in St. Augustine. A chance meeting with Rebecca Zetterower would change the course of Jim's life. Jim met Rebecca in the lobby of Flagler Hospital in St. Augustine. That meeting led to a beautiful friendship, romance and marriage three months later. Jim was a kind and wonderful gentleman. He persevered through bad health and led a positive, selfless life. He had a heart for the homeless and frequently volunteered at the cold night shelter for the homeless. He was a member of First United Methodist Church. He will be deeply missed.

James was preceded in death by his parents, James and Anna Spalding. He is survived by his wife, Rebecca "Becca" Zetterower Spalding of St. Augustine; Stepsons, Bradley Bunch and Darren Bunch of Fernandina Beach,

FL, a sister, Kathy Giangrande and husband Bill of Orlando, FL; and a brother, Greg Middleton of Leesburg, FL.
