James Henry "Jim" Wall, age 93, of St. Augustine, Florida, passed away peacefully at his residence on July 6, 2025.

Born in Belle Rive, Illinois, Jim was the son of the late Henry A. and Violet Wall. He proudly served his country in the United States Air Force during the Korean War, demonstrating the dedication and sense of duty that would define much of his life. After his military service, Jim continued his work in aviation as an aircraft mechanic and pneumatic shop chief for the Indiana Air National Guard 181st TAC Fighter Group until his retirement as a Master Sergeant.

A longtime resident of Clinton, Indiana, Jim was deeply involved in veterans' organizations.
