Jeanne (DiBiase) Williams, formally of Scituate, RI passed away peacefully on Saturday, September 16, 2023, in St. Augustine, FL at the age of 78. She spent the day surrounded by her friends and family.

She leaves behind her beloved husband of 56 years and constant companion Alfon (Al) Williams. She also leaves behind her two adoring sons and daughters-in-law David Williams (Karen) and Mark Williams (Kathleen).

Jeanne was the cherished grandmother of five grandchildren, Mark Williams, Jr., Abigail Slader (Nathan), Joseph Williams, Hannah Williams, Natalie Williams who all affectionally called her Nonni.

She was predeceased by her father Joseph DiBiase, her mother Elizabeth (Rosati) DiBiase, her stepmother Concetta (Feula) DiBiase, and her sisters Ann Marie (Malcom) Kdonian and Rosalie (Frank) Como. She is survived by her stepbrother John Lorenzo (Karen Farrell).

Together they raised their children in Cranston, RI. Once her children were young adults, Jeanne reentered the workforce as a full-charge bookkeeper. After retirement they moved to Scituate, RI (wintering

in Punta Gorda, FL) and finally to Elkton, FL full-time.

Jeanne devoted her life to her family and friends. She showed her love through her cooking, by singing to her grandchildren, making life-long memories, and settling the incessant debate between her sons as to which was her favorite (the answer changed quite often).

When she wasn't doating on her family, Jeanne enjoyed reading, golfing, and playing cards. She loved to sing, dance, and entertain – be it friends, family, or perfect strangers.

The daughter of Italian immigrants, Jeanne prided herself on preserving her family's Italian traditions while embracing the American heritage that surrounded her. She was always fair, honest, and compassionate while never compromising her values and beliefs.

Her greatest pleasure came from spending time with the people she loved. Her lasting legacy is a testament to a life well lived and well loved. She will be missed immensely.

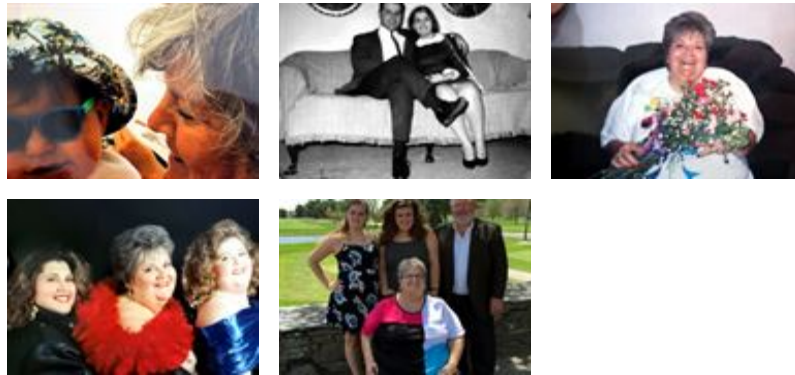
