I am so sorry for your loss. She does live on in you in many ways but missing her in physical presence, I know, is very hard.

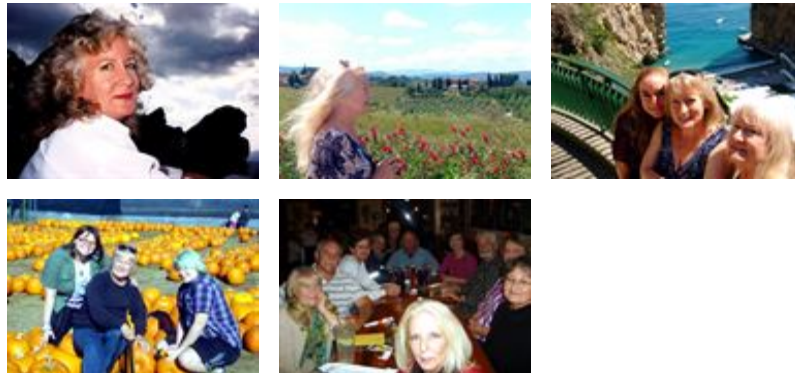
May she rest in peace or romp with horses in heaven. Whatever she wants. She's earned it.
