John Beals Remensnyder, age 84 of St Augustine, FL passed away peacefully on March 29, 2023 at Community Hospice Bailey Family Center.

John was born in New Rochelle, NY, the son of the late Warren S. Remensnyder and Doris Beals Remensnyder. As a youngster, he moved frequently due to his father's job requirements spending his earlier years in New York, Michigan, Illinois, and Brazil returning to his birthplace as a young teenager. He was a graduate of New Rochelle High School and New York University where in June of 1960 he received a bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering and a commission as a 2nd Lieutenant in the United States Army. He served two years of active duty with the 2nd Armored Division in Fort Hood, Texas. John's love of aircraft and his fascination with jet engines led to a very successful career in the aviation industry with United Technologies Corporation's Pratt and Whitney division where he completed 36 years of service both at their facilities in Connecticut and Florida. John and his wife Barbara fell in love with the Blue Ridge Mountains during a visit in 1983 and they subsequently built a vacation home in Edneyville, NC in 1987. John retired at the young age of 57 years old from Pratt & Whitney in 1996 to travel the world with his wife Barbara and enjoy time with family and friends. John and Barbara picked St. Augustine, Florida for their winter retirement home in addition to enjoying their Edneyville mountain home during the summer months. In 2001, John and Barbara decided to live in the mountains year-

round, building a new home in Flat Rock, NC. After many enjoyable years in the mountains, John and Barbara moved back to St. Augustine fulltime to enjoy warmer weather and nearby family.

As a devoted Roman Catholic, John was active in the Lector and Eucharistic Ministries at several Parishes as well as a 3rd Degree Brother in The Knights of Columbus. For 16 years, he devoted many hours as a volunteer counselor with the AARP Tax Guide Program for seniors and low-income clients. He enjoyed golf for many years, traveling the world with Barbara and tracking expenses and investments on his Apple Computer.

A loving husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather, he is survived by his high school sweetheart, best friend and devoted wife of 63 years, Barbara; a son David Remensnyder and his wife Maria of Myrtle Beach, SC; a son Gary Remensnyder and his wife Lori of St. Augustine, FL and his daughter Carol Berman and her husband Barry of Palm Beach, FL; grandchildren Christian and Danielle (Cory) of Myrtle Beach, SC, John, Andrew and Anna of St. Augustine, FL, and Christopher (Ashley & Noah), Matthew and Nicole (Kevin) of South Florida. He is also survived by his half-brother Ricardo Remensnyder, his wife Candida and nephew Tomaz of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

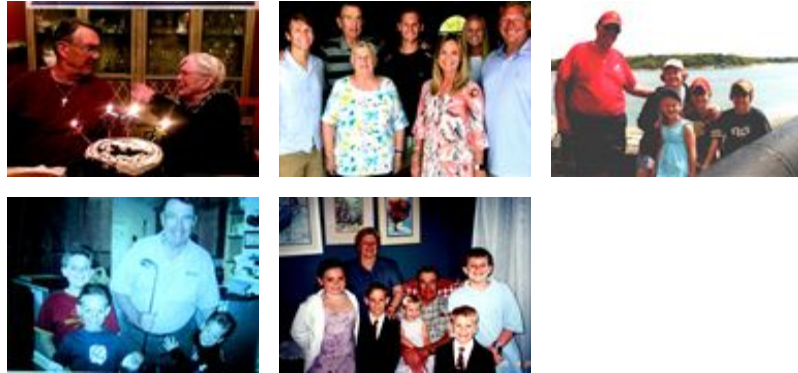
