Julia Marian Russell passed away peacefully on April 24, 2025, at Bailey Center Hospice in St. Augustine, Florida. She was 87 years old.

Born on July 5, 1937, in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, Julia was the daughter of Marian Baker and Sterling Harry Cromwell. She grew up on a farm alongside her two siblings, Gail and Charles, instilling in her a strong work ethic.

Julia graduated from Savannah High School in Georgia and later attended Baltimore Business School and Towson State College. Over the course of her life, she lived in many parts of the United States, spending two years in Mexico as well, reflecting her independent spirit.
