Katie Lee Douglas Weeks, 101, of St. Augustine, passed away on Friday, July 25, 2025. She was born in 1924 in Horseshoe Beach, FL. Her father, Christopher Columbus Douglas, founded the town and instilled in Katie a love for adventure and determination. Her mantra was “I can do anything I put my mind to.” and she did. Raised on a remote country farm, Katie wound up traveling the World. She married Herman Weeks, who was to become a colonel in the Air Force and, with him, raised two daughters, Valerie and Judy. Katie lived in France, the Azores, Virginia, and Ohio, Georgia, and finally back in Florida, where it all began. First the Gulf and then the Atlantic. She even managed to get in a trip to India and spent time on a houseboat in the Himalayas.

Katie adored living on the beach, tending to her patio garden, and becoming what folks at Atlantic East called their “treasure”. She was happiest when her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren came to visit. Katie had boundless energy and always believed that if the room was quiet, something must be wrong. She was an avid volunteer. Working with her church, and for many years volunteered as a greeter and librarian at the Riverhouse, part of the council on aging. An elegant and beautiful woman who brought laughter and sunshine wherever she went. We will miss her.

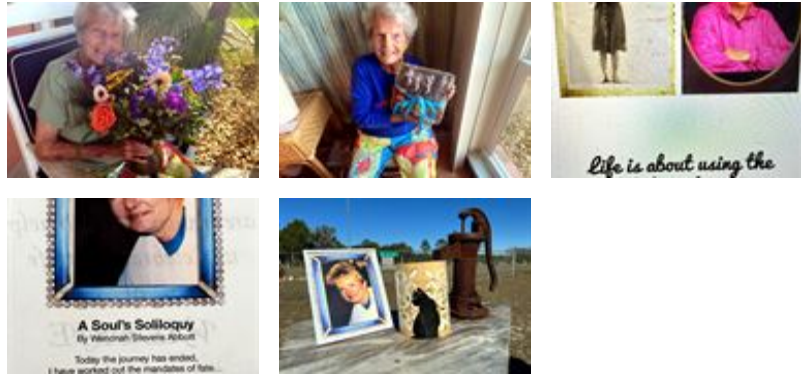
