



## Ken Green

February 28, 1942 - March 28, 2022

Ken Green, age 80 of Saint Augustine Florida passed away on March 28, 2022 at Flagler Hospital. He lived in Barton Maryland for over 32 years then moved to Merritt Island, Florida in 1973 and relocated to Saint Augustine in 1979. He worked for Ponce de Leon resort and the Castillo de San Marcos and on Saturday mornings hosted a radio talk show called Lifeline on WFOy. Ken lived a life of service to others. He was vice president of St. Johns County Right to Life, Florida Right to Life, Full Gospel Businessman Association, Marketplace Ministries and Alpha Omega House. 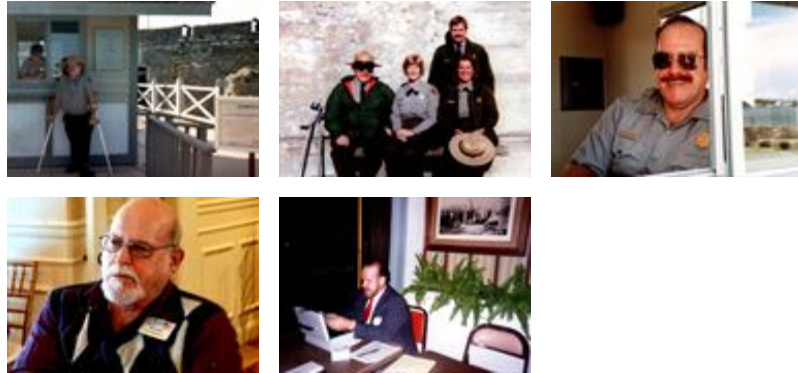
