Kyle L. Allen, age 21, of St. Augustine, died unexpectedly on Sunday, February 5, 2012, on the campus of Presbyterian College in Clinton, S.C. Kyle was a native and lifelong resident of St. Augustine and was a 2009 graduate of Pedro Menendez High School. An accomplished linebacker on the Menendez football team, Kyle served as team captain for 2 years and helped lead his team to its first playoff berth in school history. He was selected to the All-County team by the St. Augustine Record and received honorable mention honors on the Class 3A All State team. He was currently a student at Presbyterian College in Clinton, S.C. where he was a business administration major and a member of the football team. Kyle has been referred to as "the epitome of the All American kid". He was a quiet leader who had touched so many lives, and was well respected by his teachers, coaches, and peers. He is survived by his mother, Lucy Allen and her fiance' John Long of St. Augustine; his father, Scott Allen of Jacksonville, sisters, Kelly Allen and husband Matt and Kayla Allen, all of St. Augustine; brothers, Kevin Allen of St. Augustine, Zane Allen and Luke Allen, both of Michigan; and many aunts, uncles, and cousins. He is also survived by the love of his life, and longtime girlfriend, Carice Parker, and her family. He was preceded in death by maternal grandparents, Louis Cook, Jr. and Shirley Johnston, paternal grandparents, Roland & Millie Allen, and an aunt, Lee-Ann Lekas. Funeral

services will take place at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, Feb. 10, at Good News Church. Interment will follow at San Lorenzo Cemetery. A visitation will be held from 2 to 4, and from 6 to 8 p.m. on Thursday at St. Johns Family Funeral Home.
