It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Le'Quitia Shawon King, who departed this life on February 11, 2026, at the age of 43. Le'Quitia was a native and lifelong resident of St. Augustine. She was a graduate of St. Augustine High School with the class of 2000. A gifted student, Le'Quitia went on to graduate with a Bachelor of Business Administration and MBA from University of Phoenix.

Le'Quitia started her working career at the National Guard Armory. 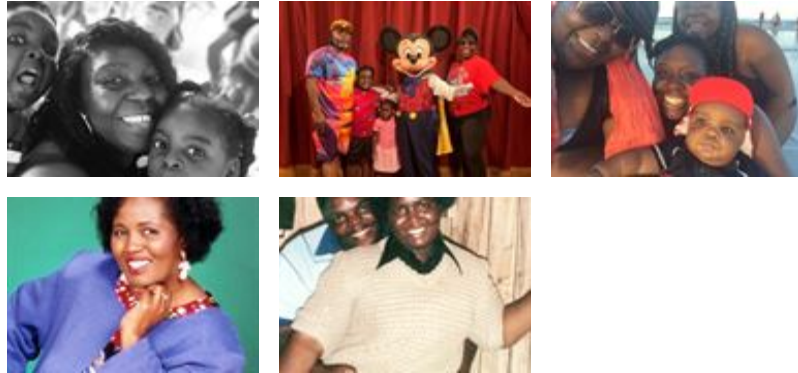
