



## Lois Cooper Leeth

Lois Cooper Leeth, of St. Augustine, Florida, died on June 22, 2021 at the age of 100. A native Floridian, Lois was born in Greenville, Florida in 1920. She graduated from Gainesville High School in 1938 and from Florida State University (formerly Florida State College for Women) in 1942 with a degree in English. She was a member of Kappa Alpha Theta sorority. Lois worked for most of her career as a teacher in Virginia, Georgia, Florida, Alabama, and Kentucky. She retired after many years of teaching in Kentucky. She was an avid nature lover, enjoyed birding and shelling, and authored books on nature.

Lois was preceded by her husband, Jack D. Leeth, Sr., of Louisville, Kentucky. She is survived by her sons, Jack D. Leeth, Jr. and Richard S. Leeth, both of St. Augustine, Florida, Stewart T. Leeth and his wife, Billie Leeth, of Richmond, Virginia; her granddaughter, Annie Leeth of Atlanta, Georgia and a host of devoted nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
