She worked with the State of Tennessee then for Memphis State University and later as the Information Center Supervisor at the University of Memphis. Her genuine, sincere, and selfless nature shone through in all aspects of her life. Lois was known for her protective love for her family and friends, always giving of herself to those around her.

Glover; and brothers, David Ray Glover, James G. Glover, Laymon C. Glover, Jr., Bobby L. Glover, and Tommy Glover.
