Loren Theodore "Ted" Keller, age 83, of St. Augustine, died peacefully on July 28, 2016 at Flagler Hospital in St. Augustine. Ted was born and grew up in Ellwood, Pennsylvania, graduating from Ellwood City High School in 1950.

After his graduation from high school he moved to Miami, Florida and enrolled at the University of Miami. During his college years he joined the U.S. Army and served as a Green Beret as a member of the first Nuclear Weapons Division in Alamogordo, New Mexico. After his discharge from the Army, Ted returned to the University of Miami where he completed his degree in Civil Engineering, graduating from the college in 1958. Ted enjoyed a career of more than 30 years as a Civil Engineer. For most of that time he owned and operated a land development business and worked on projects in Florida and abroad. After his retirement, he moved to St. Augustine in 1990. Though he continued to work in his retirement, Ted enjoyed playing golf at Marsh Creek. He was an active member of Memorial Presbyterian Church. More than anything Ted was a loving husband and father, and he will be deeply missed. He is survived by his loving wife of 64 years, Daisy Keller of St. Augustine, his daughter, Deborah Gordon (James) of Coral Springs, FL.; a son, Jeffery Keller of Miami; grandchildren, Jennifer Griffin and Alexis Keller and a great granddaughter, Riley Griffin.
