Louis Joseph Galbiati, Jr., 85, of Glenmoor in St. Augustine FL, died June 4, 2010 at the Mayo Clinic. He was born in Vineland, NJ and was a longtime resident of New Hartford, NY and Andover, MA, where he served as Chairman of the School Committee and a Scout leader during the 60's and 70's. He was a sergeant in the U.S. Army during WW II serving in the Philippines and Korea. Lou received a BSEE from the Johns Hopkins University and a PhD in Electrical Engineering from Cornell University. He served many years as a professor and Dean of the SUNY College of Technology in Utica and was the author of a textbook on machine vision. He was a member of the American Society of Engineering Education (ASEE), the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers (IEEE), and Robotics International. He was a member of Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic Church in St. Augustine and will be interred at Spring Grove Cemetery in Andover at a later date.
