Marcia LaMarca Dooly, age 81, of St. Augustine, FL went home to be with our Lord on December 1, 2016. Marcia's passing was preceded by her husband the Rev. Canon Bernard Dooly of St. John's Cathedral in Jacksonville, FL.

She is survived by her two daughters of Panama City Beach, FL, Marta Rose-Thorpe (Jimmy) and Liz Bennett (Mike); sister Linda LaMarca; four grandchildren, Rylee, Michaela, Isabel and Leo; niece Lisa Hobelmann; nephew Eric Hobelmann (Anne); great nieces and nephews, Cley, Kyle, Claire and Joshua. Marcia was born in Englewood, NJ and moved to Florida at age 15 with her Swedish mother and Italian father. She earned her MA in Education at the University of Florida, and continued working on her PhD at Florida State University, studying Home & Family Life and Gerontology. While living in Tallahassee she was an active leader at the Senior Center. Marcia moved to St. Augustine in 1972 and opened the Owl Studio in the Restoration area, an eclectic gift shop showcasing many of her talents. An accomplished artist all her life, she painted, sketched, sculpted, batiked, sewed, created one-of-a-kind jewelry, and wrote fiction novels based on her life's travels and journeys into human nature. Always a strong advocate for quality education, Marcia launched New School in 1974, a K-12 private school in Elkton, FL.

This undertaking lead to meeting her husband, Fr. Bernie Dooly, and the two were married for 39 years. During their life together they traveled extensively

through Europe, at one point living in Ireland, Bernie's homeland, for ten years. Marcia's passions extended to her family and beloved pets, and she loved hosting reunions and gatherings at her and Bernie's home in Summer Haven, La Mystique Sur Mer. Her Celebration of Life will be held on Sunday, December 11 at 2:00 pm at St. John's Cathedral, 256 E. Church St., Jacksonville, FL. Immediately following the service will be a gathering at her home in Summer Haven for family and friends.
