Margaret Ann Alberter, 86, of St. Augustine, passed away on May 22, 2012 at Flagler Hospital. She was born Margaret Ann Murphy in Pittsburgh, Pa. on July 2, 1925, the oldest of six siblings and was the last surviving sibling of the family. She was a resident of St. Augustine for 24 years. Margaret Ann and Bob, her husband of 64 years, raised their family in Pittsburgh before striking out on their own. They moved to Cleveland and then to San Francisco to maintain Margaret Ann's position with United Airlines, begun in 1963, which afforded them the opportunity to travel the world. Margaret Ann was with United Airlines for over 20 years, retiring as a reservations supervisor. She always said their extensive travels changed their lives. Her Irish heritage and Catholic faith were two of the major influences in her life. She greatly enjoyed jazz, crosswords, political discourse, family and friends. Margaret Ann is survived by her husband Bob, daughters, Kathy Alberter of Hillsborough, N.C., Susan Alberter of Yellow Springs, Ohio and a son, Rob Alberter of Pittsburgh, Pa. She is also survived by five grandchildren and one great grandchild. A memorial mass will be held at 9 a.m. on Monday, May 28, at St. Anastasia Catholic Church with a reception to follow in the social Hall.
