Margaret "Peggy" Lehe Magras, age 69, of Saint Augustine, Florida, passed away peacefully on April 27, 2025.

Peggy was born in Camden, New Jersey, on May 27, 1955. Later, moved to Doylestown, Pennsylvania, where she spent much of her childhood in the historic farm home once owned by Oscar Hammerstein II. She then relocated to Puerto Rico, where she graduated from the Episcopal School in San Juan. Eventually, Peggy settled in St. Augustine, Florida, where she lived a life deeply rooted in faith, family, and service.

She earned her Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education and Teaching, followed by a Master's Degree in Counselor Education, School Counseling, and Guidance Services from the University of North Florida in 1992. Her passion for nurturing young minds led to a fulfilling career as a teacher and guidance counselor. She later served as a homebound instructor for children facing medical challenges, offering education and encouragement during their most difficult times.

A devout Christian, Peggy found great joy in reading her Bible, journaling, tending to her beloved plants, and spending time with her cherished pets. Her generous heart extended to numerous local charities, and her playful, charismatic spirit brought smiles to everyone she encountered. In her younger

years, she also modeled and appeared in television commercials, carrying herself with grace and confidence.

Peggy is survived by her husband, Jeffrey Magras; her brothers: Thomas Lehe Jr. of Palmer, Alaska (Heather), James Lehe of Hoover, Alabama (Linda), and John Lehe of Anchorage, Alaska (Martha); her sister, Mary Anna Lehe; and many nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by her father, Thomas Lehe; her mother, Nina Arana Lehe; and her sister, Virginia Etridge.

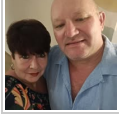
