Martin J. McLaughlin, age 89, of St. Augustine, passed away on May 22, 2012 at the Samantha Wilson Care Center at Bayview. Born in the Bronx, New York, he was a longtime resident of Patterson, NY. Martin served in the U.S. Army, under General George Patton, during WWII. He was with the invading force at Normandy, and fought in the Battle of the Bulge. After the war he returned to New York and went to work for Con Edison, starting as a pipe fitter and retiring as a crane operator. He was Chairman of the Democratic Club in Patterson, where he served as President. Martin moved to St. Augustine in 2005, after living in Michigan for many years. He was a loving husband, father and grandfather, and he will be deeply missed. He is survived by his wife of 65 years, Virginia McLaughlin of St. Augustine; three daughters, Lorraine McLaughlin and Kathleen Price, and her husband, Daryl, all of St. Augustine, and Virginia Krawczuk of Pawling, NY; a son, Martin J. McLaughlin, and his wife, Jean, of Montgomery, NY; grandchildren, Jason Price, Kristie Reyes, Kathryn McLaughlin, Lorraine McLaughlin, Amy McLaughlin, Casey Krawczuk and Blake Krawczuk; and a great-grandson, Roderick Reyes.
