Mary 'Marika' Tsannis Brokas, 90, of Keystone Heights, passed away peacefully at The Pavilion at Penney Farms, on Sunday, January 25, 2015. She was born in Akron, Ohio on June 22, 1924. She was the first female lay reader at St. Anne's and the first woman to serve as Senior Warden on the Vestry. She also served on the Altar Guild, sang in the choir, and was the organist and Parish

Administrator. She volunteered countless hours using her many talents and spiritual gifts. She then moved her membership to Trinity Episcopal Church where she continued to volunteer at the church office. She was a member of The Daughters of the King and very dedicated and devoted to her church families. A memorial service will be held at 3:00 P.M. Sunday, February 1, 2015, at Trinity Episcopal Church, 204 Highway 26, Melrose, FL with The Rev. Tony Powell and The Rev. Harold L. Ritchie conducting the services.
