Mary Mesa, age 85, of St. Augustine, passed away peacefully at the Bailey Family Center for Caring on November 9, 2022. Mary was born to Pablo and Guillermina “Lola” Lllerna in Candelaria, Pinar del Rio, Cuba. After graduating from high school the family moved to La Habana so that she could attend the University de La Habana where she graduated with a bachelor’s degree in Political Science and a minor in Mathematics. In Cuba, Mary worked as a teacher of mathematics. In July 1962 she immigrated to the United States where she settled in New York, New York. There, she began work for IBM, responsible for data input.

In New York, Mary met her husband to be, Luis Mesa, through mutual friends. They married on April 8, 1967, and went on to have two daughters, Rose Marie and Irene. In 1976, they moved their family to Boca Raton, Florida where they raised their daughters and enjoyed with them the peaceful lifestyle that comes with beach living.
