



Mervin Thomas "Tom" Adams

Mervin Thomas "Tom" Adams, 79, of Palm Coast, Florida, passed away on November 2, 2024, at AdventHealth Orlando. Born in Punxsutawney, Pennsylvania, Tom grew up in Dora, Pennsylvania, where he developed a love for learning and community service.

A proud graduate of Penn State University, Tom earned his degree in mechanical engineering before pursuing his passion for ministry at Nazarene Bible College in Colorado Springs, where he obtained his pastoral degree.

Tom dedicated his life to serving others, pastoring for three years in Bradford, Pennsylvania, before relocating to Florida. He continued his ministry at Lake City Nazarene Church for five years and then at St. Augustine Church of the Nazarene for 27 years, where he left a lasting impact on countless lives.

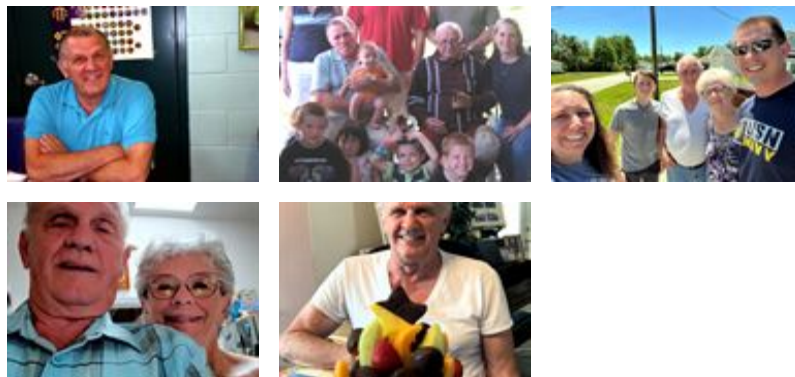
