Michael Edward Molloy, age 29, of St. Augustine, passed away unexpectedly on May 27, 2021 at his home in St. Augustine. Mike was born in Philadelphia and grew up in Lansdale, Pa. He was a talented musician and played guitar and drums in local bands growing up. After graduating from high school he attended community college in Lansdale and moved to St. Augustine in 2011 to attend Flagler College. In 2014 he graduated from Flagler College with a bachelor's degree in Elementary Education. While attending Flagler, Mike worked as a cook and server in local restaurants, and most recently had been working in restaurant management. He met his wife to be, Lindsey Wintamute, and married her on October 4, 2019. Mike enjoyed reading and was an avid video gamer. He was loved by his family and friends and he will be deeply missed.

He is survived by his wife, Lindsey Molloy of St. Augustine; his parents, Michael & Marianne Molloy of Lansdale, Pa.; his brother, Matthew Molloy of Lansdale, Pa.; and a paternal grandfather, George Molloy of Philadelphia, Pa.

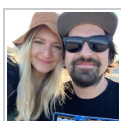

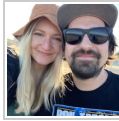
