Mike had a charm that made strangers into friends and a way to bring laughter and light to the toughest situations. His compassion, love, on-point sarcasm, and perfectly off-the-cuff dad jokes always cut through the noise.

Mike had a way to bond with all the kids and bring the best out of them, giving them memorable experiences like nobody else could.

Mike leaves us with a million yottabytes of data in memories to treasure; from helping us navigate life, supporting our aspirations and dreams, to amazing adventures, wholesome moments, and irreplaceable experiences.

Mike lived by what he called the four F's: faith, family, fun, forgiveness.
