Mildred Ruth "Chris" Noble, age 97, of St. Augustine, passed away on Monday morning, Sept. 23, 2013 at the Bailey Family Center for Caring. Born in Newport, Rhode Island as the daughter of a career Naval Officer, Chris grew up in many places including Denton, Maryland, Key West & Jacksonville, Florida, and Texas. She was a beautiful woman and a talented entertainer. She taught herself to dance at a young age and put her skills to use as a volunteer with the U.S.O. during W.W. II. She continued to dance and perform in the Theater in Michigan and Jacksonville, and did some modeling work in automobile advertising for the Chrysler Corp. For nearly forty years, Chris enjoyed working as a Mary Kay Consultant. She had been a resident of St. Augustine since 1979, moving here from Stone Mountain, Georgia and was a longtime member of Anastasia Baptist Church.
