He retired in 1994 and took to the sea, pursuing his passions of travel and sailing. He and his wife, Jennifer and their fearless dog Daisy moved to Sunset Harbour Yacht Club in Miami Beach and sailed around the Caribbean Sea visiting many countries and beautiful places. He moved to Coquina Crossing in Elkton Florida in 2006 and lived out the rest of his years. He enjoyed relaxing and talking with his friends and neighbors at Coquina Crossing.
