After many more years she retired and left her extended "Poor Walts" family to spend time with her kids and grandchildren. Joe's daughters, Brittany and Erica; Debbie's daughters, Jade and Jenna and Chuck's sons Tim and Tom. In 2001 Nancy suffered yet another unexpected loss, the death of her oldest son Chuck.
