A virtual memorial service will be done in the future to remember her. She wanted her body donated to science for others to learn from so that has successfully been done.

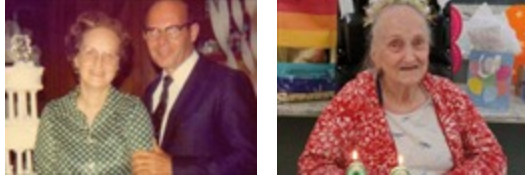
