During WWII he flew 30 missions as an Aerial Gunner on a B-17 Bomber and was the recipient of many awards and commendations. Norman went on to work for many years as an airline mechanic for Eastern Airlines. He was a longtime resident of Miami, Florida, and had been a resident of St. Augustine since 1984. He was a Mason and an active member of Anastasia Baptist Church. Norman had a great affection for his outdoor cats and loved to feed the raccoons around his home. Above all, he was a devoted husband, father and grandfather, and he will be deeply missed. He is survived by his wife of 71 years, Aleene McFarland of St. Augustine; a daughter, Sherry Smith, and her husband, David, of St. Augustine; a grandson, David Bryant Smith of Ft.
