On Monday September 20, 2021, longtime St. Augustine resident Paul E. Hayes passed away at the age of 96. Paul was born on March 26, 1925 in Shinnston, West Virginia. Paul was the youngest of six children. He was a World War II Veteran and served in the U.S. Navy as a First-Class Seaman until 1941.
