Richard J. "Dick" Lauginiger, age 74, of St. Augustine, passed away on July 21, 2011 at the Bailey Family Center for Caring in St. Augustine, surrounded by his family. He was born and raised in Chester, Pennsylvania, and served his country in the U.S. Air Force. He was a longtime resident of Miramar, FL. He worked for Southern Bell where he began as a lineman and retired while working in management. Dick also had a long history of volunteering, starting with his service as a Volunteer Paramedic/Fire Fighter in Miramar. After retirement Dick moved to Lenoir, NC, where he resided for ten years, before relocating to St. Augustine in the late 1980's. Upon moving to St. Augustine, Dick continued to volunteer on numerous committees and ministries in his church and as a Public Service Assistant with the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office. In 1998, he was hired by the Sheriff's office as Senior P.S.A. and continued in that role until a month before his death. He served for a total of 16 years with the Dept. and enjoyed every minute of it. He was a member of Crescent Beach Baptist Church, and had also been a longtime member of Anastasia Baptist Church.
