Richard D. "Dick" Goede, age 74, of St. Augustine, passed away on Wednesday November 19, 2014 at his home surrounded by family. Dick was born and grew up in Omaha, Nebraska and graduated from Omaha Central High School. He moved to Miami, Florida in his early 20's where he graduated from Embry Riddle Aeronautical University in 1962. He began his career as an Executive pilot for Northern Natural Gas in Omaha, Ne., and in 1965 he went to work for TWA in Kansas City, Mo. He enjoyed a 36 year career with TWA, starting out as a 1st Officer and spent the majority of his career as a Captain. During his career, he also served as a Test Pilot, Flight Instructor, Line Flight Manager and International Check Pilot. He retired from TWA in 2000. He also worked at Simcom as a Simulator Instructor after retirement. He was a longtime resident of Lawson, Mo., and was a member of The Greater Kansas City German Shepherd Dog Club where he served a term as President. He moved to St. Augustine in 1999 and was a member of the Village Church at World Golf Village. Above all, he was a loving and devoted husband, father and grandfather, and will be deeply missed. He is survived by his wife of 14 years, Marlene "Marty" Goede; daughters, Richelle "Rikki" Goede (Sue Walker) of San Jose, California, Liz Kessler (Doug) of Lawson, Missouri, Cheryl Jones (Danny) of Dallas, Texas; son, Mark Goede (Gina) of St. Louis, Missouri; brother, Larry Goede (Rebecca) of Brownsville, Texas, 7

grandchildren and 4 great-grandchildren. A memorial service will be held at 3 pm on Saturday, January 24, 2015 at The Village Church with Pastor Bob May officiating.
