Richard L. D. Hammond, 83, of St. Augustine, Florida, passed away on August 28, 2022, at Baptist South Medical Center in Jacksonville, Florida. He was born on September 21, 1938 to Maurice and Lucille Hammond in Lansing, MI. Richard was a graduate from Lansing Eastern High School and graduated from Michigan State University with his Bachelors Degree. He served his country for 4 years in the United States Army working as a Finance Officer, serving mostly in Germany.
