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Richard Edward Taylor, II, age 34, formerly of St. Augustine, died tragically of injuries sustained in a motorcycle accident on July 25, 2013 in Silver Spring, Maryland. He was born and raised in St. Augustine, Florida, and attended St. Augustine High School. Richard worked in Facilities Maintenance for many years, starting out at the Ponce Care Center in St. Augustine. He also worked for 3 ½ years at J & J Maintenance in Augusta, GA, as a subcontractor for the military. Richard had been a resident of Silver Spring, MD for the past year. He was well known and loved in the community, but more than anything he was a devoted husband to his wife Ginger, and a loving father to his daughter, Peyton. He is survived by his wife, Ginger Taylor of Titusville, FL; a daughter, Peyton Marie Taylor, also of Titusville; his father, Richard Taylor, and fiancee Cassandra Turcotte, both of St. Augustine; his mother, Deborah Kelly of Texas; sisters, Dana and Billie Jo Lawrence; paternal grandparents Richard and Pat Taylor of St. Augustine; his father & mother-in-law, Ivan and Nancy Gantenbein of Titusville, FL; an uncle, Thomas Taylor and his wife, Juanita, of Tennessee; and aunts Sue Boyd and her husband, Sam, also of Tennessee, and Carol Taylor of St. Augustine.
