Robert Henry "Bob" Leone, age 71, of Saint Augustine, passed away on Nov. 7, 2014 at his home, surrounded by his family. Leone dedicated his life to serving his community. A lifelong resident of Monessen, Pennsylvania, Leone was Mayor of the city for two terms. He served in the city's volunteer fire department for 25 years and held the post of municipal fire chief for 12 years. In addition, he was president of the Monessen Chamber of Commerce from 1988 to 1989; Monessen Community Chairman of the Mon Valley United Way from 1986 to 1987; Treasurer of the Monessen Rotary from 1988 to 1989; President of Rotary from 1989 to 1990 and was Chairman of the Mon Valley Charities committee. He also served on the Monessen Community Development Corporation, Monessen Youth Entrepreneur Program and the Mon Valley Education Consortium and had been a sponsor of youth and adult sports activities for 20 years. Leone was co-sponsor of the Monessen Juvenile Committee and member of the Mon Valley Steel Temperance Committee. Leone was selected as Man of the Year by the Monessen Democratic Committee in 1991. Additionally, he was a Third Degree Knight of Columbus and a member of the Elks. Leone began his service station career on Third Street at the former "Esso", before owning numerous businesses: Panorama Enterprises, Eastgate and Gateway Exxon, and Forever Jewelry and Awards. In his spare time, one of his favorite hobbies was sharing his love of cars with

his grandsons. Leone moved to Saint Augustine Florida in 2013 with his wife of 53 years: his high school sweetheart. He is survived by his wife, Antoinette "Toni" Leone of St. Augustine; daughters, Robin Leone (Don Rhodes) of McMurray, Pennsylvania, Renee Krivacek (Phil) of St. Augustine; and his five grandchildren, Leigha, Blaine, Quintin, Angelena, and Hannah.
