Robert Michael "Bob" St. Clair, of St. Augustine, died suddenly on March 26, 2016 at his home. Born and raised in Jersey City, New Jersey, Bob lived for a time in Hazlet and in Toms River, NJ. In 1984 he moved to Sarasota, FL, before relocating to St. Augustine in 1996. Bob worked as a Custodian at the Florida School for the Deaf and Blind and was a partner with his wife, Chanel, in several gourmet food stores including Hot Stuff Mon and Olive This Olive That for many years in the St. Augustine historic downtown area. He previously owned and operated the Fenton Glass Shop and earned the distinction of being a Silver Dealership. Bob had a great sense of humor and loved to tell a good story. He was a familiar face in the historic district of St. Augustine and he never met a stranger. Bob enjoyed traveling, taking cruises, and boating. Above all, he was a loving husband, father and grandfather, and he will be deeply missed.
