Robert "Bob" Marvin, 92, passed away peacefully on Thursday, June 12, 2025, under the compassionate care of Haven Hospice in Orange Park, Florida.

Born on March 11, 1933, in Akron, Ohio, Bob was the son of Harvey Leon and Elizabeth Glendy Marvin. He was a proud graduate of East High School in Akron, and soon after graduation, he answered the call to serve his country by joining the United States Air Force. Over the course of a distinguished 21-year military career, Bob rose to the rank of Tech Sergeant, serving as a Crew Chief on fighter jets and winding down his military career in the field of avionics. He retired from the Air Force in May of 1972.

Following his military service, Bob continued to work in the field of technology with Burroughs/Unisys Corporation, where he spent another 20 years as a Computer Technician before retiring in 1992. He initially made his retirement home in St. Augustine, Florida, later relocating to Fleming Island in 2019.

Bob had a passion for mentoring and served many years coaching youth football and baseball. He was also active in school athletics, serving as the

Booster President for the N.B. Forrest Rebels from 1979 to 1980. A devoted Florida Gators fan, Bob enjoyed many hobbies throughout his life, including bowling, boating, fishing, playing the guitar, and traveling the country in his RV.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his sister, Louise; his beloved wife, Betty Sue Sanders Marvin; and his grandson, Ronald Ray "Bo" Marvin.
