



## Roberta Lee Fynn

Roberta Lee Fynn, age 73, of Green Cove Springs, passed away on April 18, 2019 at St. Augustine Health & Rehab Center with her husband by her side.

Roberta was born and grew up in Orville, Ohio and lived there for most of her adult life. In her youth she spent many years working as a horse trainer in Ohio. One of her greatest accomplishments in life was training a quarter horse named "Great Pine" who became a champion quarter horse. During the 1980s, Great Pine was the leading sire of National Reining Horse Association money earners and was the leading maternal grandsire of the 1990s. Great Pine was inducted into the AQHA Hall of Fame.

Roberta married Peter Fynn on May 16, 1996. She lived with Peter on a sailboat in Ft Myers for several years before moving to California in 2002. The couple returned to Florida in 2010 and enjoyed cruising the intracoastal waterways on the east coast of Florida. She had been a resident of Green Cove Springs since 2013. More than anything, Roberta was a loving wife, mother and grandmother and she will be deeply missed.
