Roberta “Bunny” Lois Okie Newman Pomar, age 73, died in her home in St. Augustine, Florida on January 9, 2019. Born in Jacksonville, North Carolina to predeceased Marvin and Diane Okie, she spent most of her childhood and early adult life in the Philadelphia area before moving to Florida in 1992 following the death of her first husband, Gilbert Newman.
