



## Rocco Louis Mallardi Jr

January 30, 1945 - May 5, 2020

Rocco Louis Mallardi, Jr., age 75, of Hastings, FL., born in New Rochelle, New York, passed away unexpectedly on May 5, 2020 at UF Shands Hospital in Gainesville. He served his country as a U.S. marine and fought during the Vietnam War. After his honorable discharge he worked as a marine mechanic, welder, locksmith, motorcycle rebuilder, an EMT, police dispatcher, and he was a fireman at the Mount Vernon fire department in New York; he really was a jack of all trades. He raised his family in New Rochelle, NY with his wife, Pamela.
