Roddy Alirio Intriago, 88, born in Chone, Manabi - Ecuador on September 11th, 1929, passed away peacefully on February 13th, 2018 surrounded by loving family. Roddy was preceded in death by his parents Cecilio Intriago-Cedeno and Dioselina Intriago Zambrano-Gomez, three brothers, Cecilio Intriago, Klever Intriago and Francisco "Frank" Intriago.
