Dr. Roland G. Tremblay, age 96, of St. Augustine, died Wednesday, August 7, 2013 at his home, with his family at his bedside. He was born on June 2, 1917 in Somersworth, New Hampshire, the only son of Peter and Bernadette (Demers) Tremblay. He was a physician and surgeon who practiced medicine from 1947 until 1980. Tremblay is survived by two daughters, Gail, of Olympia, WA, and Linda Maxwell of Golden, CO; a grandson, and two great-grandsons. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Leela (Young) Tremblay, the mother of his daughters, and by his second wife, Anna (Ames) Tremblay.
