



## Ronnie Edward Terrell

Ronnie Edward Terrell, 74, of Hastings, passed away on January 31, 2026, at UF Health Flagler after a brief illness.

Ronnie was born on July 16, 1951, in Tuscaloosa, Alabama, to the late Willard Terrell and Ruby Baker. He moved to St. Augustine at the age of 12 and had been a resident of the area for the past 62 years.

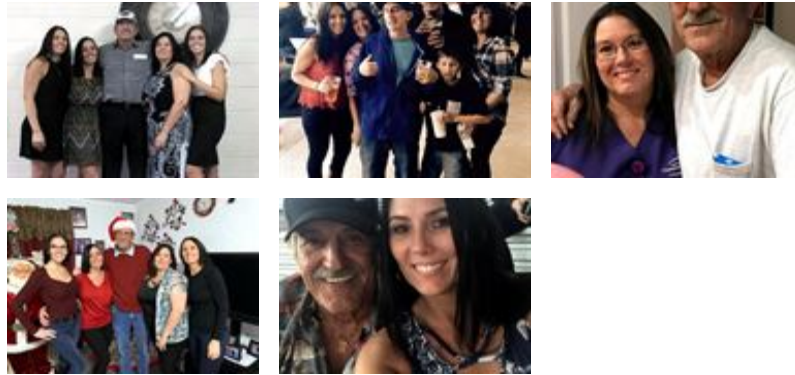

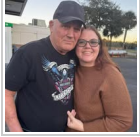

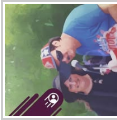
I've been doing Ronnie for many years and work with him occasionally
