Church, former Sunday school sectary, teacher, Assistant Superintendent, Usher Board member Choir member of both I and II, former steward and Trustee. She was a stewardess. She also helped her mother in the kitchen for many years. She also was church secretary for many years.

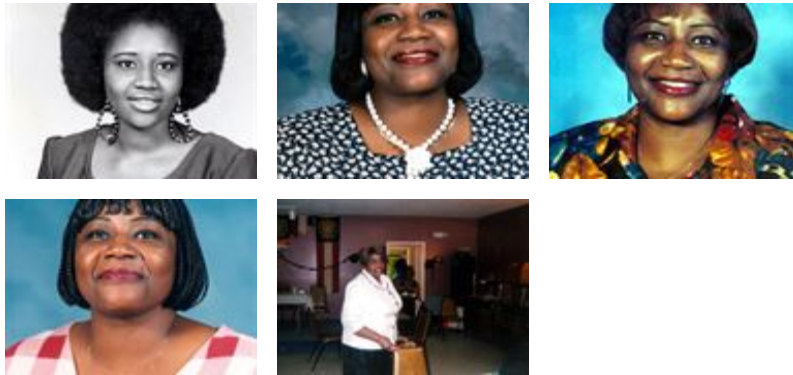
